The 3rd annual gala dedicated to our road to a cure for Metastatic Breast Cancer

## Our Purpose

In 2023, the American Cancer Society estimates about 297,790 new cases of invasive breast cancer will be diagnosed in women\*— In 2020, two of those women were family members Kerry O'Riordan McAdam and Jacquie Reynolds Beck. Although Kerry and Jacquie were both shocked by their Stage IV diagnoses, they did not allow breast cancer to define or cripple them. Instead, they made a conscious decision to fight their battles head on by partnering with METAvivor to host the Philadelphia METAvivor Gala. In 2022, Kerry passed away from metastatic breast cancer, but her spirit will live on as we continue to fight for a cure in her honor. Our 3rd annual fundraising gala aims to educate, raise awareness, and help find a cure for Stage IV, Metastatic Breast Cancer. And, most importantly, 100% of the proceeds from the Philadelphia METAvivor Gala will be donated to METAvivor!

Cerry's Story

Kerry's story begins in June 2019 when, at the age of 29, she found a lump on her left breast while shaving in the shower. After a visit with her OB-GYN and an ultrasound, Kerry was told that the lump was nothing more than a benign cyst and was advised to follow up in six months. At her follow-up appointment in January 2020, however, it was discovered that the lump had grown. An ultrasound turned into a biopsy of her lymph nodes, which revealed that Kerry had Stage IIB breast cancer. From there she met with a medical oncologist, a radiation oncologist, and a breast surgeon to determine the best course of treatment. Encouraged by the optimism of her doctors, she began preparing herself for a double mastectomy, followed by chemotherapy and radiation, with hopes of receiving the "all-clear" by the end of 2020. Plans quickly changed when it was discovered that the cancer had already spread to her liver and skull, leading to Kerry's diagnosis of Stage IV, Metastatic Breast Cancer.

When Kerry was diagnosed at age 29, she was the picture of health and had no family history of breast cancer. Despite her diagnosis, however, Kerry exuded bravery, hope, and positivity, and lived each day with MBC to the fullest. She planned her wedding, spent precious moments with friends and family, and spoiled her beautiful nieces. Sadly, at just 31 years old, Kerry died from complications of metastatic breast cancer on Tuesday, April 26, 2022. She passed peacefully in the comfort of her home surrounded by her adoring husband, sweet sister, and loving parents.

Jacquie's Story

Jacquie's story begins several years ago: In 2011, Jacquie had her annual breast exam and screening mammogram, which revealed that she had Stage 0-1 breast cancer. She treated her breast cancer aggressively with a double mastectomy, reconstructive breast surgery, and hormonal therapy. Then, early in 2020, after Jacquie had been in remission for nearly eight years, she suddenly began having pain on her right side near her liver as well as weight loss, fatigue, and night sweats. Jacquie went to her primary care provider who then referred her to an oncologist. The oncologist ran the gamut of tests: blood work, an ultrasound, a CT scan, an MRI, and a liver biopsy. These diagnostic tests revealed that Jacquie's breast cancer had returned and spread to her liver, bones, and brain, leading to her diagnosis of Stage IV, Metastatic Breast Cancer in May 2020.

Jacquie has gone through numerous lines of treatment over the past few years. She is currently on an infusion chemotherapy regimen with gemcitabine + carboplatin. She takes a cognitive pill every day to help prevent memory loss from the whole-brain radiation and gets IV infusions of Zometa every few months to help prevent osteoporosis.





### MBC Expert: Dr. Pedram Razavi



### MD, PHD MEMORIAL SLOAN KETTERING CANCER CENTER

Dr. Pedram Razavi is a medical oncologist and physician-scientist focusing on precision oncology in breast cancer. He directs MSK's Breast Molecular Tumor Board, Breast Translational Platform, and Liquid Biopsy and Genomics in the Biomarker Development Program. His research concentrates on integrative clinicogenomics and circulating tumor biomarkers to guide translational breast cancer research; characterize cancer on a systemic and molecular level; and to expand clinical applications of liquid biopsies. He leads several large-scale genomic and liquid biopsy studies on breast cancer evolution, biomarkers of response and resistance to targeted therapies, and outcomes prediction. These efforts have led to the identification of novel mechanisms of resistance to major targeted breast cancer therapy modalities while shedding light on new and potentially druggable genomic drivers of breast cancer.

Dr. Razavi earned his medical degree from Tehran University of Medical Sciences and an MPH and a PhD in cancer epidemiology with a focus on population genetics at the University of Southern California, followed by a postdoctoral fellowship at Channing Laboratory in Boston. He completed an internal medicine residency at USC and a medical oncology fellowship at MSK, where he was also a postdoctoral fellow focusing on cancer genomics in the laboratory of Dr. José Baselga. He joined MSK's faculty in 2016. At the 2024 gala, Dr. Razavi will speak on the topic of "Shifting the MBC Paradigm."
