The station is self-serve and has the capability to top off or fully charge an electric vehicle while the firms employees are at work or its clients are attending a meeting at the firm. Considering one-third of the nations greenhouse gases come from transportation and sixty percent of that is from personal vehicle use, electric vehicles can make a tremendous impact.
