I think when people are happy and feel good about their place of work, they treat each other better and perform better, and that spills over to the experience of our clients.

The article emphasizes the full-service commercial business law firms strong belief that its employees should be treated as justly as its clients. We dont sell merchandise; we sell a service, said Spirgel. So our assets are our employees, which is evident in the long list of perks employees are offered just for working there. Along with a full range of health, disability and life benefits, there is a profit-sharing plan for all employees, tuition reimbursement and legal service benefits available. In addition, there is a fully equipped gym and locker room facility onsite, firm sponsored 5Ks and bike races throughout the year, yoga classes and a wellness initiative created to support the healthy lifestyles of their employees. The firm also sponsors several team-building events throughout the year, which include an annual softball game, end-of-summer party, Thanksgiving feast and white elephant holiday party.

Not only is the firm looking out for the health of its employees, but they are also taking proactive steps in helping them reduce their carbon footprint. Earlier this year, Flaster Greenberg was voted one of South Jerseys most green and eco-friendly companies for the installation of an electric vehicle curb side charging station in the firms Cherry Hill office parking lot, which is free to both employees and clients of the firm.
