Frank Riesenburger, Chair of Flaster Greenberg's Environmental and Real Estate Law Departments and Co-Chair of the Alternative and Renewable Energy Industry Group, has been asked to speak and lead discussions on electric vehicles at the Sustainability Symposium PA/NJ 2013, which will be held at the Temple University Performing Arts Center on March 12th.
