
FG's Phil Kirchner Appointed by the Supreme Court of New Jersey

Flaster Greenberg shareholder Philip Kirchner was recently appointed by the Supreme Court of New Jersey to serve as a member of the court's Advisory Committee on Expedited Civil Actions. The goal of this committee is to achieve speedier justice at a lower cost without sacrificing due process and fairness to litigants.

Judge FJ Fernandez-Vina and Thomas Curtin, Esquire will co-chair the committee, whose mission is to develop proposals to expedite litigation in actions filed in the New Jersey Superior Court, Law Division, Civil Part. As a member of the committee, Kirchner will help investigate, among other things, the types of cases receptive to expedited civil action practice; pretrial procedures to expedite civil actions; trial practices to expedite civil actions; incentives for the plaintiff and defense bars to use the expedited program; and whether the Court Rules need to be amended or new rules adopted for the program.

Kirchner is chair of the litigation department at Flaster Greenberg concentrating his practice on resolving business disputes, including complex litigation of all types of business issues in both the federal and state courts of New Jersey and Pennsylvania.
