Mr. Ruttenberg was rated "AV Preeminent" by Martindale-Hubbell and was named a 2014 "Top Attorney" by SJ Magazine. A graduate of the University of Pennsylvania Law School (cum laude, 1966), he also earned his B.S. from the prestigious Wharton School of the University of Pennsylvania (1963).

An avid golfer, Mr. Ruttenberg served as counsel to the GAP where he was an active member and volunteer. He served on GAP's Executive Committee from 1991 through 2011 and spent the last 16 years of his life serving as the association's General Counsel. His love of golf resulted in his involvement as a tournament and rules official for a variety of tournaments. He also was a past president of the American Cancer Society - Camden County Division and Woodcrest Country Club in Cherry Hill, New Jersey.
